4 archers per boss shooting in two details

- Practice:* 09.00 am to 09.45 am
- Assembly:* 09.45 am
- Commence Shooting:* 10.00 am (note: there will be no sighters)

- Drug Testing:* Record status shoots will be liable to drug testing, and competitors approached must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Applications from junior archers must be signed by a Parent or Legal Guardian giving permission for the junior to be tested if requested.
